

Creative Curriculum:

We are currently learning about the Vile Victorians! This learning branches out into every area of our curriculum. We go on a trip to Holdenby House, where the children get to dress up as Victorians and experience what life may have been like. The children will need a Victorian costume for this trip and also for Victorian day in school.

Maths:

During the term we will cover a range of mathematics topics, including written calculations, word problems, measures, handling data and fractions. We will also spend time focusing on mental maths strategies.

Home:

You can help your child at home by:

- Checking that your child is reading independently for at least ten minutes every evening and asking questions about what they have read.
- Helping your child to learn their spelling list.
- Encouraging your child to practice times table facts and corresponding division facts.
- Checking that your child completes their homework. Please check homework slips which state when homework is due and how long your child has been given to complete it.
- Ask your child to show you what they have been doing in Numeracy, SPaG and handwriting.

Literacy:

We will be focusing on reading comprehension, SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar) and writing a range of text types. These include a book study focusing on the novel 'Street Child', poetry and recounts.
