

## Creative Curriculum:

This term we are learning about WW2 and looking at why the war started, evacuees, the Blitz and the Holocaust. During the second half of the term we plan to visit Harrington Museum. A letter about this trip will be sent home shortly.

## Maths:

During the term we will cover a range of mathematics topics, including place value, written calculations for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, shape and angles, fractions and measures.
